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TAILORED PLAN LAUNCH AND TAILORED CARE MANAGEMENT



The Trillium Tailored Plan launched on July 1, 2024. Welcome packets were mailed and new information is **posted on our website.** We have also posted the questions and answers from **our virtual information sessions.**

Beneficiaries who covered by the Tailored Plans receive behavioral health, I/DD, TBI, and physical health care through Trillium. We will continue serving members in NC Medicaid Direct, along with those who are uninsured, for behavioral health, TBI, and I/DD services.

Tailored Care Management (TCM) is a free service that pairs you with a specially trained health care worker who knows the health care system: a Tailored Care Manager. A Tailored Care Manager can assist with managing your health conditions, finding providers who take Medicaid, and more. Most Tailored Plan members are eligible for TCM and choose where they receive TCM.


