Trillium's Support Transition and Reentry

(or T-STAR) team provides support to incarcerated adults who will soon reenter their communities. Most are enrolled in Trillium. Tailored Care Management (TCM) and have serious behavioral health conditions. T-STAR also works with some individuals who are not enrolled in Trillium TCM if their Medicaid was suspended due to incarceration.

The T-STAR Team:

- Coordinates reentry by helping with housing needs, employment guidance, and community inclusion.
- Connects to enhanced behavioral health services, peer support and other community-based services.
- Facilitates primary medical care access.
- Ensures benefits like Medicaid or Social Security Disability are reinstated at release if these benefits were suspended while incarcerated.

Eligibility criteria for STAR:

- 1. Age 18 or Older
- 2. Currently Incarcerated, Expected to Release in 30–90 days to a Trillium County
- 3. Eligible for Trillium Medicaid
- 4. Serious Mental Illness (SMI) or Intellectual/Developmental Disability (IDD) diagnosis

Referral Sources:

- Department of Adult Corrections (DAC)
- County Detention Centers
- Trillium Care Managers, Member and Recipient Services
